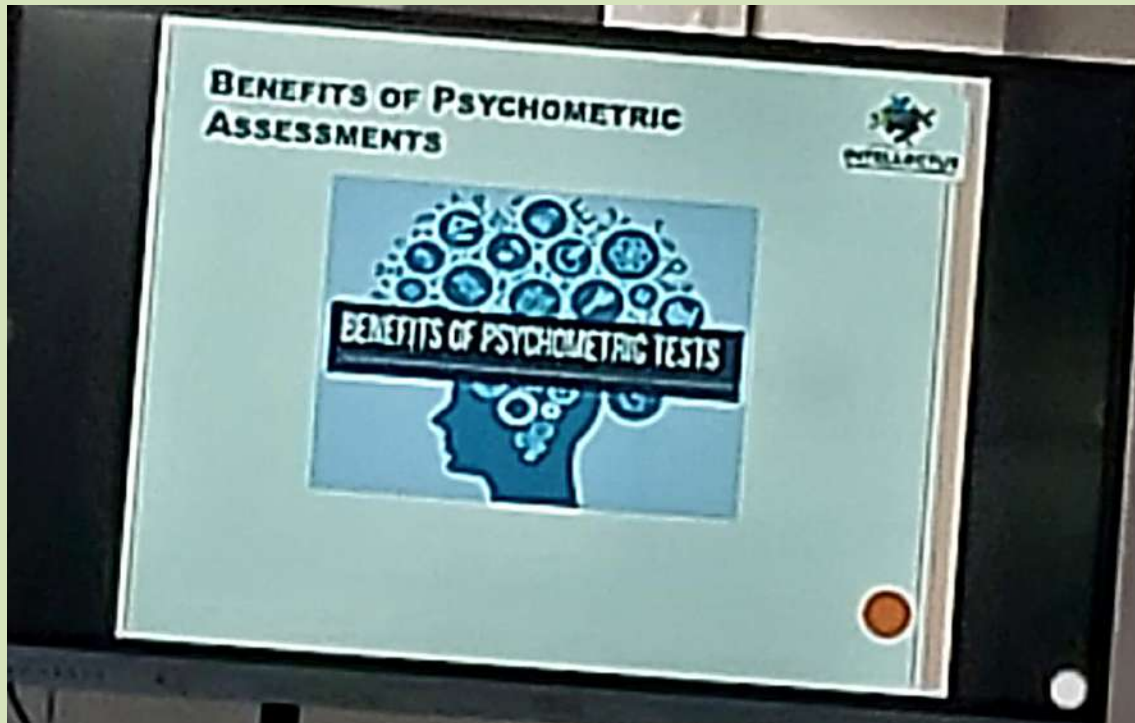

VENUE: Classroom (Silver Point School)

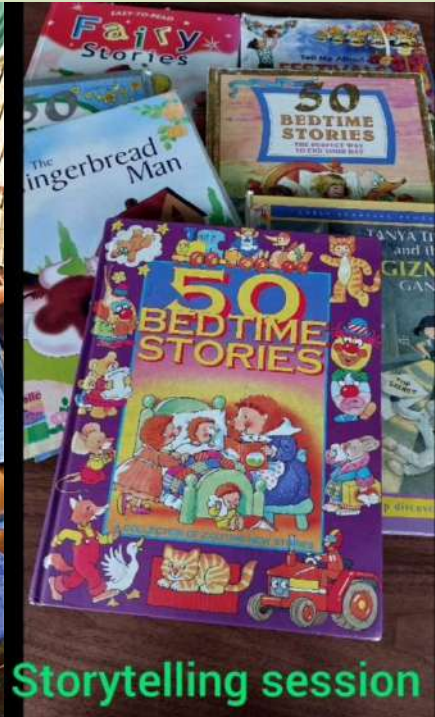
PARTICIPANTS: Students from Classes Nursery to 2.

## Eco Club Workshop – Ganesh Idol Making with Clay and Seeds.

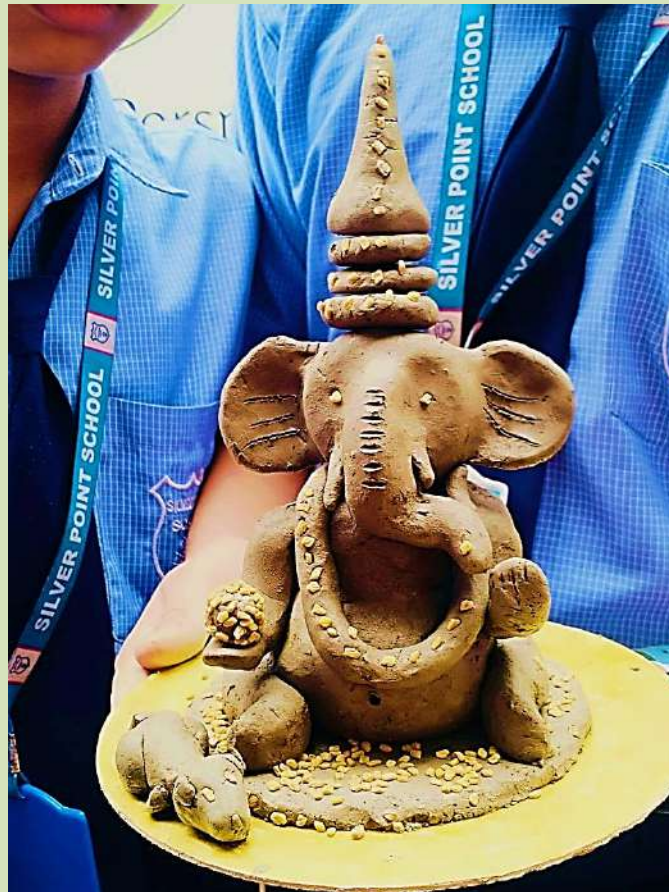
